Head Lice

Unfortunately we have headlice doing the rounds again in school.

We would ask you therefore, to check your child's hair and if lice are found, to carry out the following procedure as a matter of urgency in order to eradicate the problem.

- Wash hair with any shampoo
- Apply any conditioner to hair - it does not have to be expensive.
- Comb hair through with a tooth comb while still wet.
- Careful combing should be done every day for two weeks to ensure that all eggs are removed.

Please check your child's hair regularly and if you find head lice repeat the treatment.
