This could be support for you or your child around emotional well-being, behaviour, sleep etc. It may be there are external issues you may be dealing with that is affecting your family life.

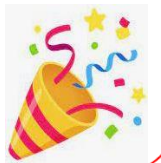
Or it could be that you are concerned about another child or family and you are unsure who to talk to or what to do.

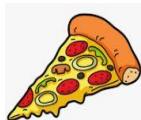
