# First Aid for Child Carers

## This course is for:

All people caring for children including parents, grandparents, child carers, teachers, school support staff and volunteers. Good citizens not in these categories might also wish to gain skills in case that unexpected emergency arises.

## You will learn:

How to assess a medical emergency

Recognise and treat blocked airways (choking)

Resuscitate a child (current covid-19 guidelines advise that resuscitation can be taught and demonstrated, but not practised by students).

Stem serious bleeding

Recognise, prevent and treat shock

Help an unconscious child and treat seizures

Understand how First Aid for Children differs from First Aid in adults

Course is targeted at treating children age 0 to 11 years, but most aspects can be used more generally.

This is a practical classroom based course which will provide an opportunity to develop your first aid skills in a friendly, sociable environment.

You will be given the support you require for your individual development.

There are no exams or formal assessments.

There will be chance to ask questions and put what you have learned into practice. Your tutor will give you feedback during the course and you will be able to self-assess.

## Work outside of sessions:

No work required outside of course. Students will be taught how to recognise sources of help in the community and set-up their own environment in preparation for an emergency.

## Additional costs and what to prepare:

Please bring a pen and paper to make notes. The course is practise based so please wear comfortable clothing that enables you to move. Be prepared to work with others within your own physical abilities.
