A reminder to please make sure that each child's school uniform is clearly labelled with his/her names.

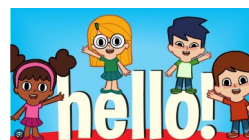
We are having lots of children misplace their jumpers and as there are no names on them, it is hard to get them returned.
