World Book Day 2023


Thursday 2 March 2023 is the annual World Book Day.

Did You Know?

Did you know School receives a Pupil Premium payment for the year in which families are eligible for free school meals and automatically for the following five years? This year it is £1385 (rising to £1,455 in April 2023) per free school meal pupil. This additional funding will be invested in your child to help them achieve more at school.

Also, did you know that the school receives a Premium of £320 for children of Armed Service Personnel? To enable school to claim this additional money please can you log on to the Parent Portal and check if you are eligible and apply for Free School Meals

To apply, you will be required to create an account, verified using an email address and provide your National Insurance Number or National Asylum Support Service Reference Number, your surname, date of birth and in a few circumstances upload a copy of your benefit document.

Once signed in, it is a quick process for parents/carers to check if their child(ren) can receive Free School Meals and they will receive an instant notification of eligibility. All enquiries are handled sensitively and confidentially. If you are eligible please send a message via Dojo to the school office, thank you for your continuing support.

Just a reminder to make sure that you keep on top of dinner money payments.

This is paid via PARENTPAY and you have to send the money for school dinners to the correct payment subject otherwise the money will just sit in your account waiting to be transferred to the correct payment topic.

If you allow school dinners to go into debt, once it has reached £20.00, we will no longer be able to provide a school dinner.

Payments are checked weekly and reminders are sent out if there is debt on your account.

Pedestrian Gate.


The pedestrian gate on Victoria Avenue will now close at 9am, instead of 9:15am.

The gate will then open at 2:55pm ready for after school collection.










