Head Lice

Unfortunately we have headlice doing the rounds again in school.

We would ask you therefore, to check your child's hair and if lice are found, to carry out the following procedure as a matter of urgency in order to eradicate the problem.

- Wash Hair with any shampoo
- Apply any conditioner to hair it does not have to be expensive.
- Comb Hair through with a tooth comb while still wet.
- Careful combing should be done every day for two weeks to ensure that all eggs are removed.

Please check your child's hair regularly and if you find head lice repeat the treatment.


Have you had a new telephone number or has the way your child gets home from school changed?

Dear Parent/Carers

Teacher Strikes

I am sure that you will all be aware from the media coverage that teaching members of the National Education Union (NEU) have declared strike action. The strikes will take place on Wednesday 1 February 2023, Wednesday 1, Wednesday 15 and Thursday 16 March 2023. The strike is happening as a result of a national dispute between the union and the government over pay and funding, and not because of any issues at our schools or our Trust.

The NEU state that they are campaigning because teachers have lost 23% in real terms against inflation since 2010 and many teachers are leaving the profession as a result. One in eight teachers leaves the profession after just a year in the classroom and one in three within five. This, in turn, reduces the number of experienced teachers in the profession. The NEU polling shows that parents support teachers taking action to protect education standards.

At Ashbrook Junior School, we do have some members of staff in the NEU so there will be disruption to school next Wednesday. I can confirm that Mars Class and Jupiter Class will be closed on Wednesday 1 February. This means that children in these classes will not be able to attend school on this day. We will update you on any future strike action as soon as we are made aware of any intention to strike.

Whilst these are the only classes currently due to be closed we unfortunately cannot confirm the scale of the disruption until the morning of Wednesday 1 February. This is because teachers can change their union before next week and could then participate in the action. I am not aware of this being something that is planned by our teachers but I need to make you aware that this is a possibility.

The decision to strike is not one that anyone takes lightly and please be assured when I tell you that teaching staff in our country are more concerned about the future of the education service as a whole and the under-funding that occurs within it than for themselves.

We will be in touch with the parents of any children in Mars and Jupiter Classes who are in receipt of Free School Meals directly. Please also get in touch with Mrs Johnstone if **all of the adults** in your home are critical workers and we will try to accommodate children within other classes.

We recognise and respect the right of our staff to take part in industrial action and ask that all members of our community continue to treat each other with respect. I understand that this situation may be frustrating and apologise for any potential disruption caused.
