
Attendance Update - Week commencing 5 February 2024


Congratulations to **Wilson** and **Riordan** Class this week for achieving the best class attendance for the week.

Unfortunately, this week we are also reporting that 4 of our classes have a weekly attendance of 93%. More on this to follow below.

Focus this week: Attendance in our school

The first chart above shows us that the 3 highest factors impacting our attendance during September to December 2023 were illness, lateness and unauthorized absence.





Unauthorised absence

When school does not agree with the reason for a child being absent from school this is recorded as unauthorised absence. This can include for example, missing school because of birthdays, weather (if school is open children are required to attend) and tiredness. These are all avoidable reasons for absences.

Lateness

We understand that on occasion lateness happens, for example traffic, incidents, unexpected car trouble, avoidable reasons for repeatedly being late include forgetting/sleeping through the alarm, being unable to find school equipment in the morning, playing games before school and oversleeping due to a late night.

Please remember : lateness counts as unauthorized absences.

Illness

When we look into illness trends we can clearly see from the chart above an increase in absences on Friday's. Further investigation shows we are receiving reports of 'feeling unwell', tummy ache and headaches are increasing on a Friday. Ensuring children are well rested throughout the week and have good bedtime routines can help children to feel ready and able to attend school through to the end of the week.

Please remember that if you are struggling with the morning or bedtime routine's we are here to help.
