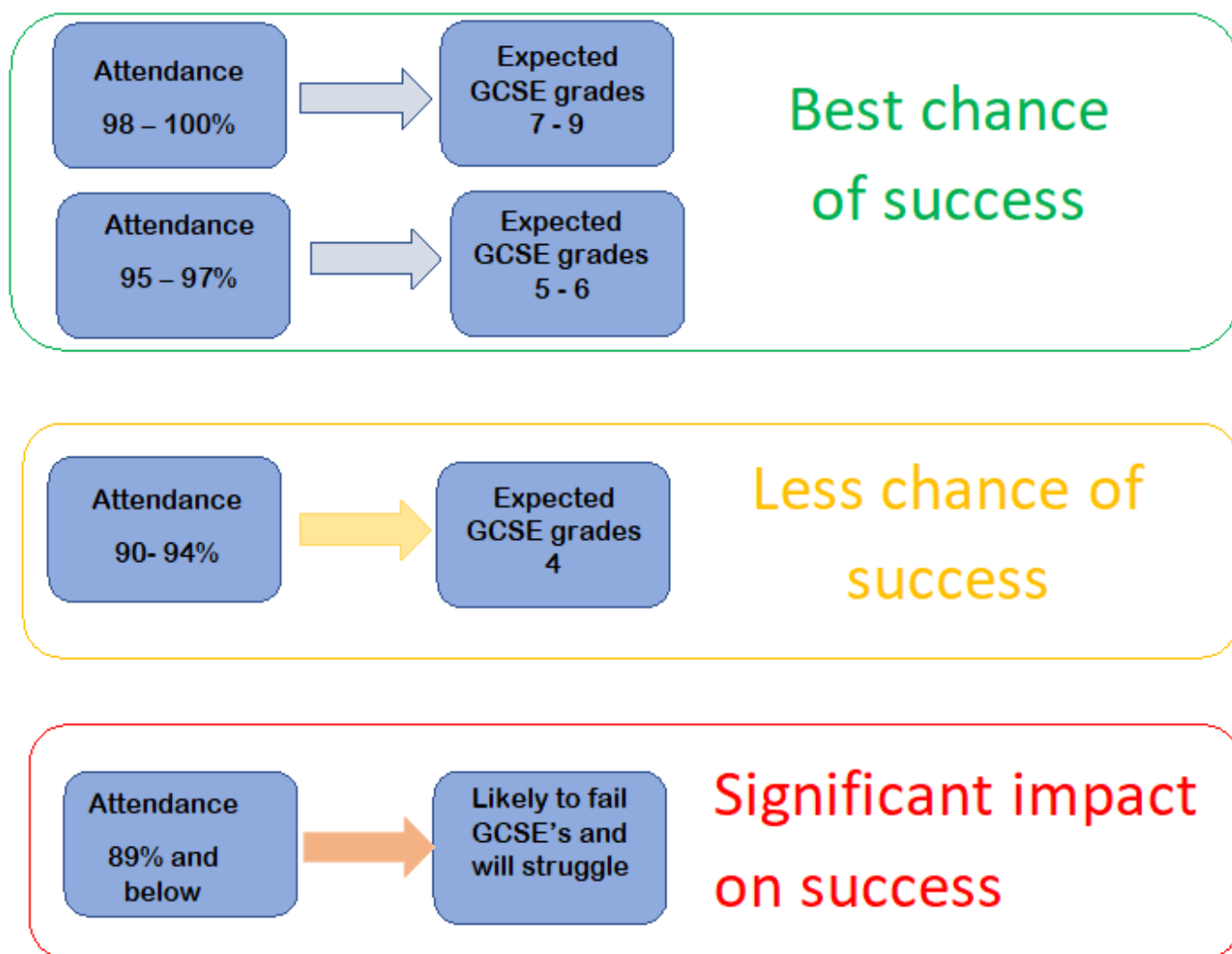


Attendance Update - Week commencing 11 March 2024
